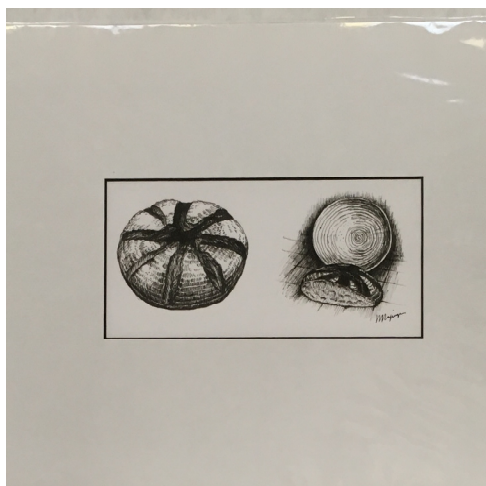

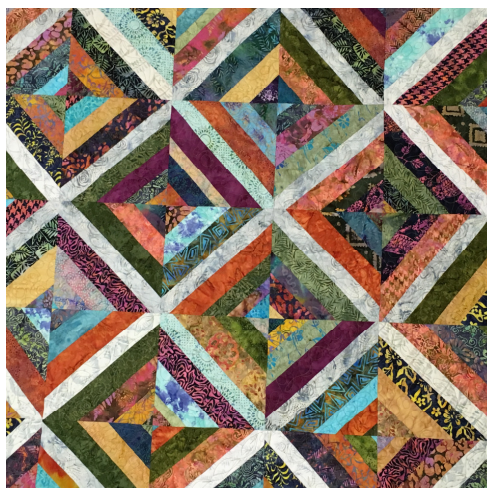
This wall hanging was adapted from a larger Magnolia pattern. It has a rolled edge technique to make curves of straight edges.

Clint picked this clock up to learn how to repair Cuckoo clocks. He cleaned, oiled, made the pendulum rod and purchased the weights.

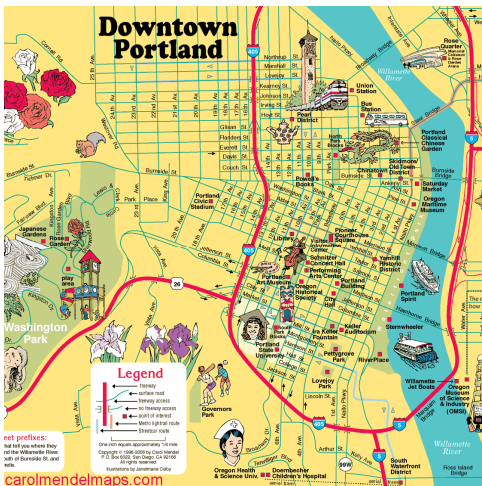
