Stephen Ministry on Hiatus for Discernment

Through this past year our Stephen Leaders have been in conversation about the sustainability of this program at PMC. They have consulted with Kristen and Rod as pastors and other previous participants of the program. This summer and fall, two of our people in leadership have needed to step away from these responsibilities, leaving only one Stephen Leader to help guide the program.

With these considerations and in consultation with the Leadership Table, PMC Pastors and SM Leaders have decided to call a hiatus or pause for the Stephen Ministry program at PMC in 2024. What this means is that we will not take on any new care receivers. Those that are in current relationships will be continuing these relationships until they come to an end naturally. Our current Stephen Leader (Joleen) has agreed to continue working with active Stephen Ministers who need supervision. Pastor Kristen will also be working on creating some pastoral care options that will be available for people in the congregation while the Stephen Ministry program is not available.

As we put the Stephen Ministry on hold for a period of time this next year, we will use that time to do some discernment on whether we have the resources to continue this program. Right now the biggest difficulty is getting people to volunteer to make this program run since it takes so much time from people who are involved. In February and March we will let the congregation know about this hiatus and make a call for engagement and feedback. We will be creating a small group to work on this discernment with pastoral support, and we hope to engage as many voices as we can. There will be a variety of ways you can share any thoughts or input you have, as we hope to have lots of conversations and also create a questionnaire that people can fill out.
